
Snack Ideas

Games to Play


Make sure to play games that everyone can participate in. The game Look Up, Look Down is a great way to make sure that everyone is involved. Have children stand in a large circle. Once the circle is formed, all the players have to look at the ground. When the moderator says "Look up!" the players have to look up and immediately look at another person in the circle. If the person they are looking at is also looking at them, they get to highfive and leave the circle. Other alternatives are Duck, Duck, Goose, Ring Around the Rosie, and Simon Says.


