- Tray or container to catch lava
- Paper cup
- Aluminum foil
- Modeling clay
- Lava mixture:
  3 teaspoons of baking soda
  1/2 to 1 cup white vinegar
  Food coloring



## CRAFT ACTIVITY

# Create Your Own Erupting Volcano

Jack and Annie learn about how volcanoes erupt in Vacation Under the Volcano. Now it's your turn to learn with this craft!



## STEP 1:

Place a paper cup onto your tray or container. Wrap the aluminum foil around it, folding the foil over the rim of the cup and shaping the remainder of the foil to resemble a mountain. This may take a few sheets of foil to create.

### STEP 2:

Take your modeling clay and flatten it with either your hands or a rolling pin. Then place the clay over the foil, folding it over the rim of the cup as well. Continue until the foil is completely covered with clay.

MAGIC TREE HOUSE



Once your volcano is built, you're ready to make the lava mixture. Pour the baking soda into the paper cup inside the volcano. Then mix food coloring with vinegar in a separate cup or bowl. Pour the vinegar and food coloring mixture into the volcano so it mixes with the baking soda.

Watch as your volcano erupts, just like in *Vacation Under the Volcano!*
