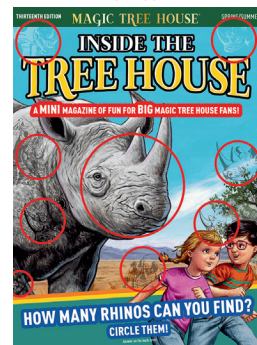

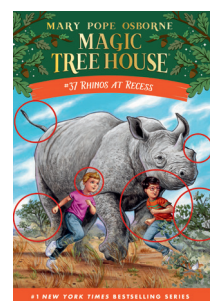

We recently caught up with Magic Tree House® author Mary Pope Osborne to discuss *Rhinos at Recess!*

What is something that you hope readers learn in *Rhinos at Recess*?

Mary: I'm a bit of both of them, but I'm not nearly as brave as Annie, and not nearly as smart as Jack.

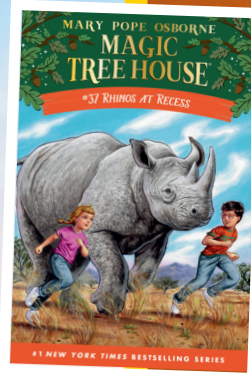
AROUND THE WORLD WITH JACK AND ANNIE!

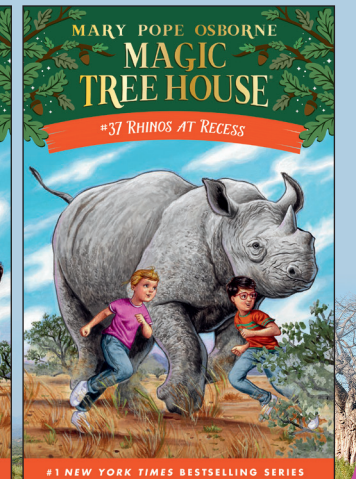
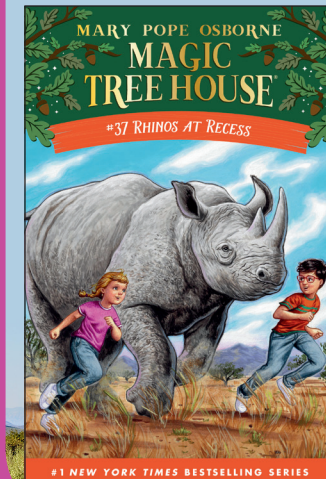

RANGERS at wildlife preserves will sometimes risk their own lives to protect the elephants, rhinos, and other protected animals from danger.

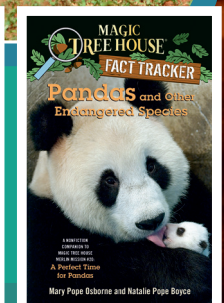
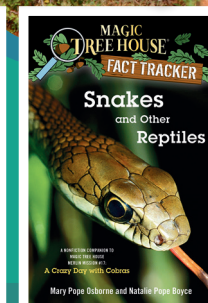
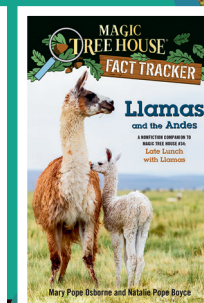
Rhinos are **PLANT EATERS**, but they are still very dangerous to humans.
