


# Sightseeing




# To the Moon and Back for You






























# Rocket's Fall Bingo!

With the help of an adult, simply attach the template to the side of your pumpkin and carve along the line.








## Directions


1. Cut strips of paper.

6. Continue until your paper chain is as long as you want it.





# Make Your Own Dragon Puppet




Your little readers can make their own dragons to take home with them!

Follow these steps to create your puppet:

- Make black-and-white copies of this page, one print out per child.
- Encourage the children to color in their dragon however they'd like! They can color their bags if they'd like as well.
- Have an adult help cut out the Dragon's head, and glue it onto the paper bag flap.
- If you'd like, cut out a square of tissue paper and attach it under the flap of the bag to look like flames.


