





To the Moon and Back for You












Hunt for eggs with Duck & Goose!








AFFIRMATION CHAIN





Directions

- 1. Cut strips of paper.
- 2. Color, decorate, and write your name and an affirmation on your strip of paper.
- 3. Tape, glue, or staple the ends together to make a loop.
- 4. Insert a second strip of paper into the loop.
- 5. Tape, glue, or staple this strip to make an interconnected loop.
- 6. Continue until your paper chain is as long as you want it.
- 7. Even after your storytime, you can keep growing your chain to represent your wonderful bookstore community.



Make Your Own


ragon Puppet

- Paper bags (one for each child)
- Glue
- Crayons and/or markers
- Tissue paper red, orange, or yellow (not necessary, but for added effect!)

Follow the these steps to create your puppet:

- Make black-and-white copies of this page, one print out per child.
- Encourage the children to color in their dragon however they'd like! They can color their bags if they'd like as well.
- Have an adult help cut out the Dragon's head, and glue it onto the paper bag flap.
- If you'd like, cut out a square of tissue paper and attach it under the flap of the bag to look like flames.
