SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED:

- A large piece of paper
- Different-colored construction paper, tissue paper, or pages from an old magazine
- A glue stick

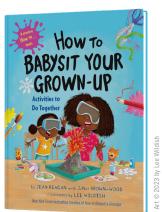
STEPS:

- 1. Use your imagination to draw a cool scene on the large piece of paper.
- 2. Rip the colorful construction paper, tissue paper, or old magazine pages into very small pieces—like the size of a dime or quarter. Make piles of different colors.
- 3. With a glue stick, add glue to your drawing. Stick on different colors of ripped paper to complete the scene.
- 4. Watch your mosaic take shape!

- Animals in a jungle
- Fish under the sea
- Your favorite trucks

How to Watch a Vegetable Drink

SUPPLIES YOU'LL NEED:

- Paper cups
- Water
- Food coloring
- Celery stalks with leaves still attached
- A small tray or takeout container topA marker

STEPS:

- 1. Fill the cups less than halfway with water. Drip in your choice of food coloring—only about two drops per cup.
- 2. Snap the bottoms off the celery. Place one celery stalk in each cup of colored water. Stir.
- 3. Draw a line with your marker on the outside of each cup to indicate the water level.
- 4. Put the cups onto the tray and place the tray on or near a windowsill in the sun. Let it sit there all day and overnight.
- 5. The next day look at the stalks and leaves. Do you see any new colors? Also check the water level—did it get lower?
- 6. Snap a piece of your celery in half or peel off the outer layer. Can you see the lines of color?
- 7. You just saw a celery plant sip water all the way to its leaves! Awesome!
