8. Hang a pole over the table and someone puts a prize on the end of your line. \_\_\_\_\_

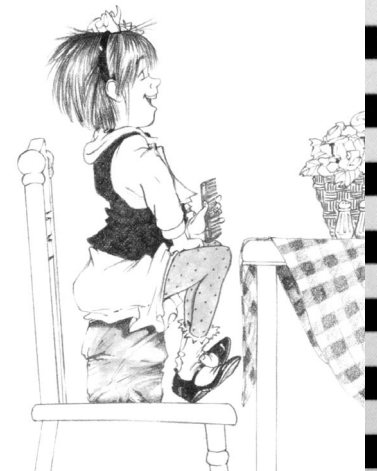
