








Best Friends Crossword





Get a Better Look at the Action

Binoculars help people observe things that are far away, and Jack and Annie find them super helpful when studying animals! Whether you're on a fantasy adventure with talking purple llamas or a fact-finding mission studying endangered animals, these binoculars will help you become a better explorer! With an adult's help, follow the steps below to make your own binoculars!



- Two toilet paper rolls or one paper towel roll
- Tape or glue
- Hole punch or, with an adult's help,
 you can use a pencil instead
- Markers/washable paint
- Ribbon/string/yarn
- Stickers, pom-poms, sequins, or anything you'd like to use for decoration



Instructions

Step 1: Take your two toilet paper rolls (or your paper towel roll cut in half) and glue or tape the two rolls together side by side. If you use glue, let binoculars dry for ten minutes.

Step 2: Time to decorate! Once the glue has dried, color and draw on your binoculars however you'd like! Add stickers, pom-poms, stamps, drawings, etc.

Step 3: Using the hole punch or a pencil, gently punch a hole on both sides of the tubes at least I/4 inch from the edge to prevent tearing.

Step 4: Cut a length of string to about 2 feet long, or long enough to attach to binoculars and go around your neck.

Step 5: Pull your string through both holes and tie the ends together in a knot.

Step 6: Explore!







A to Z Puzzle


With an adult's help, cut out the pieces along the lines and put the puzzle back together.
