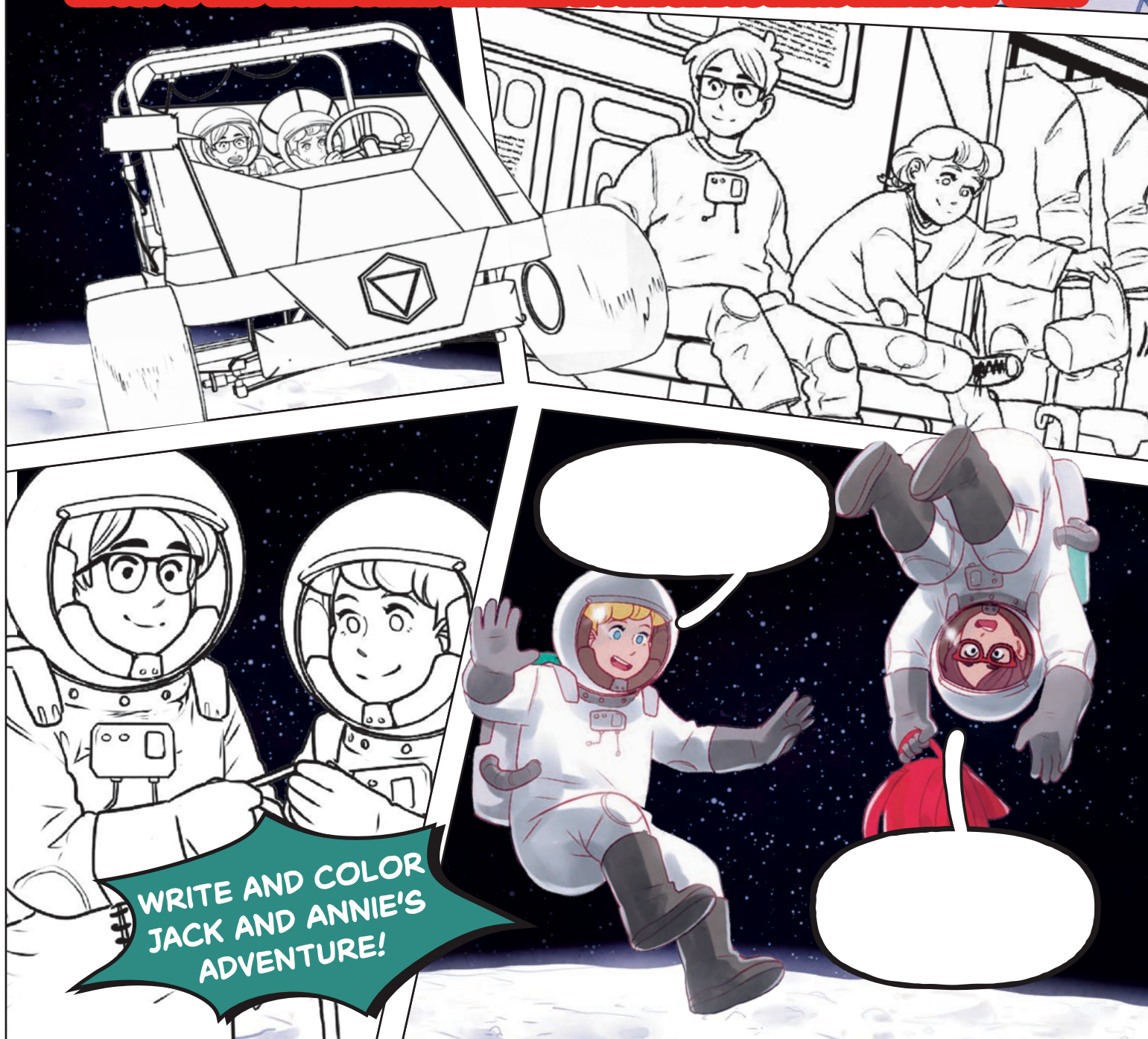

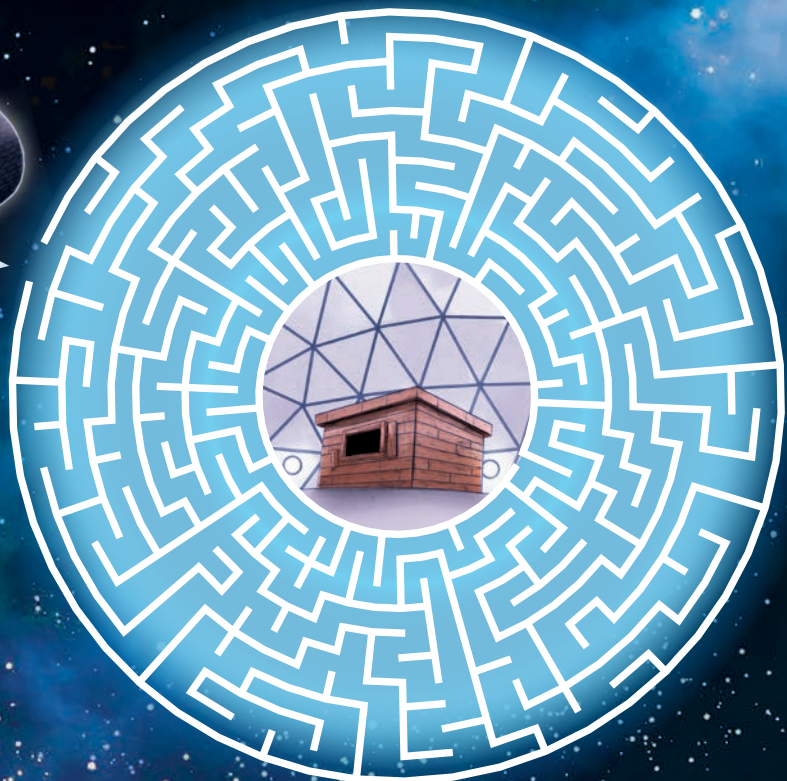
3, 2, 1... Blast Off!

Jack and Annie have enough air for only two hours! Can you help them find their way back to the moon base?

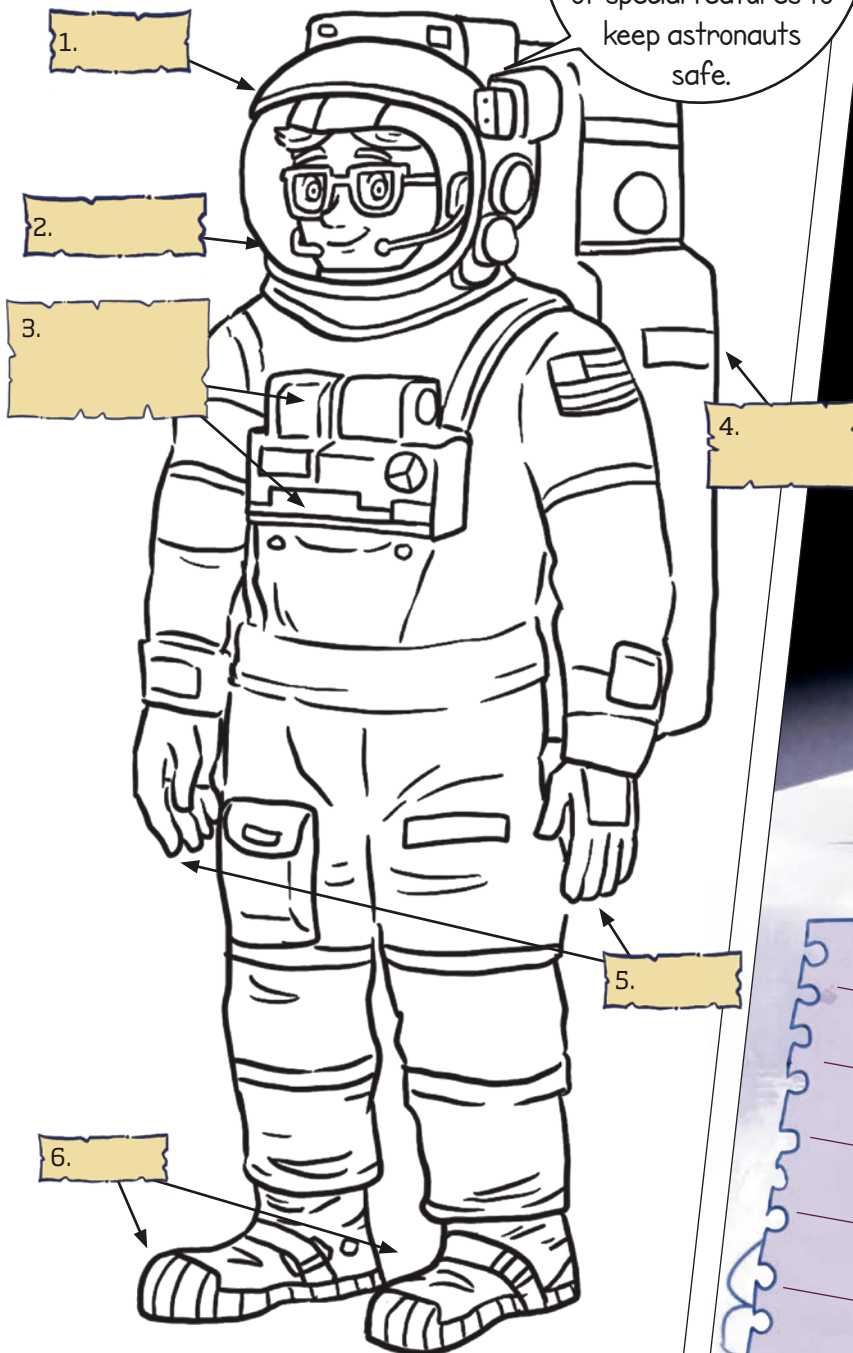


Space Suit Up!

Moon suits allowed the astronauts to walk on the moon's surface. They had lots of special features to keep astronauts safe.

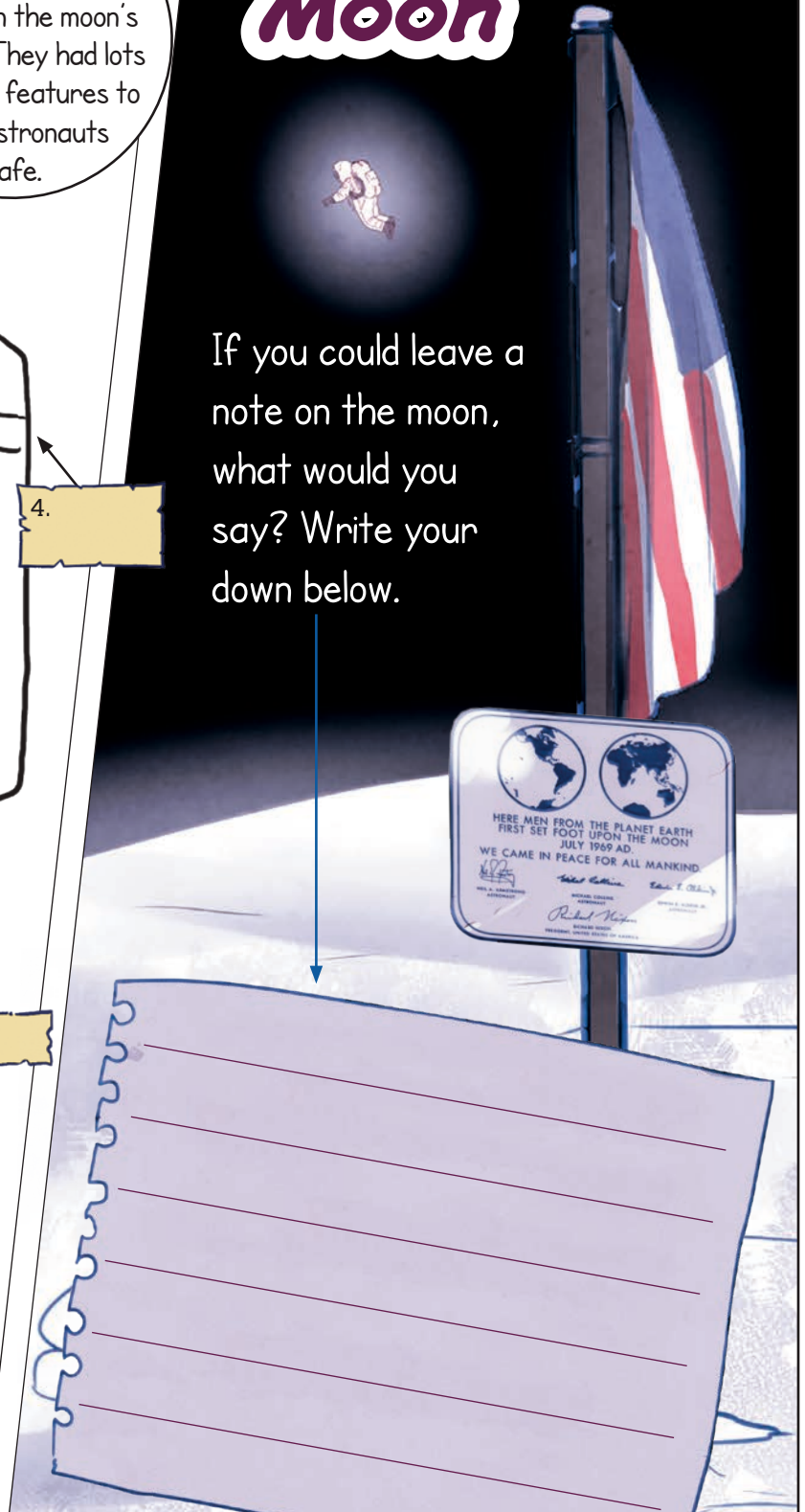

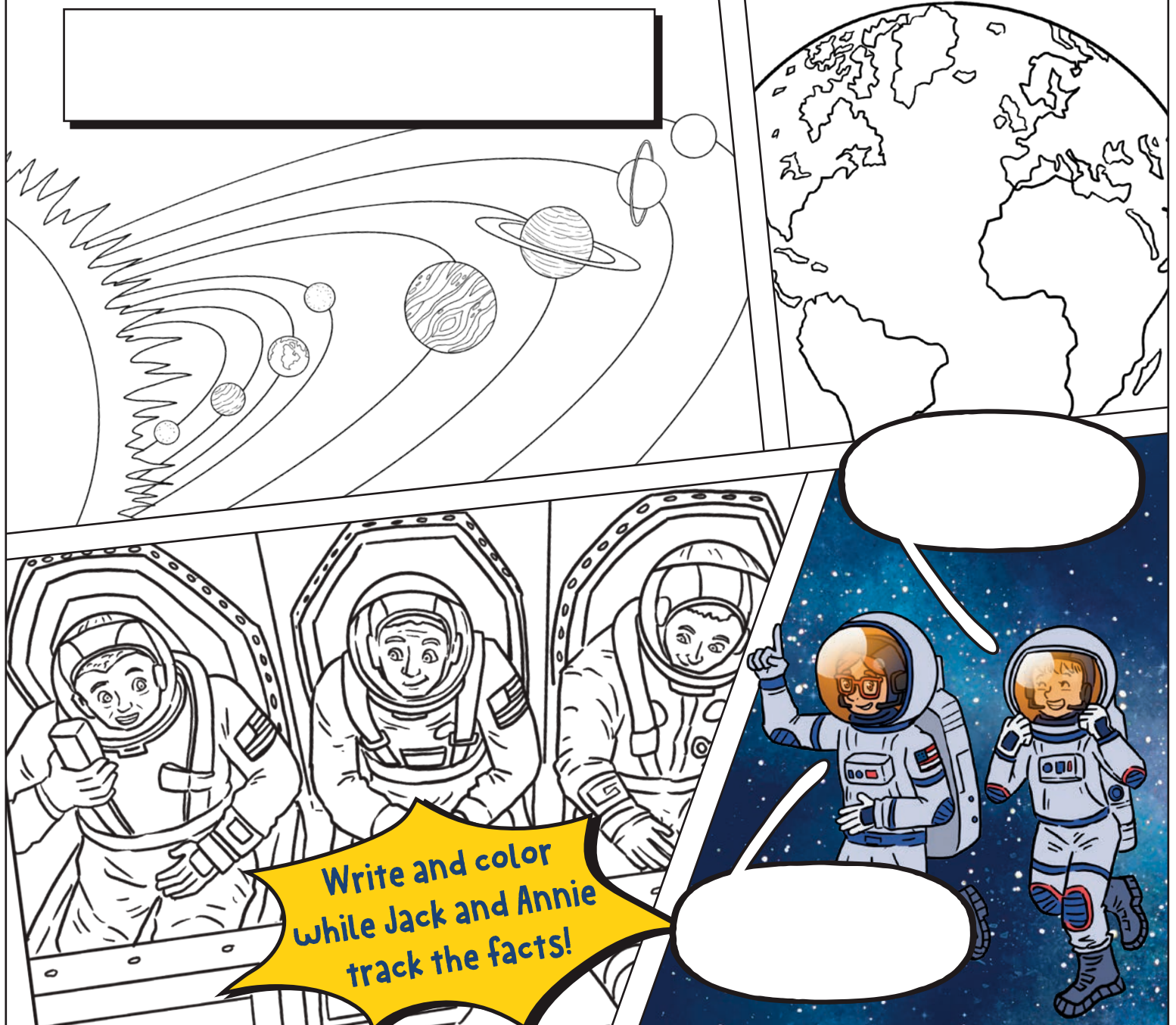

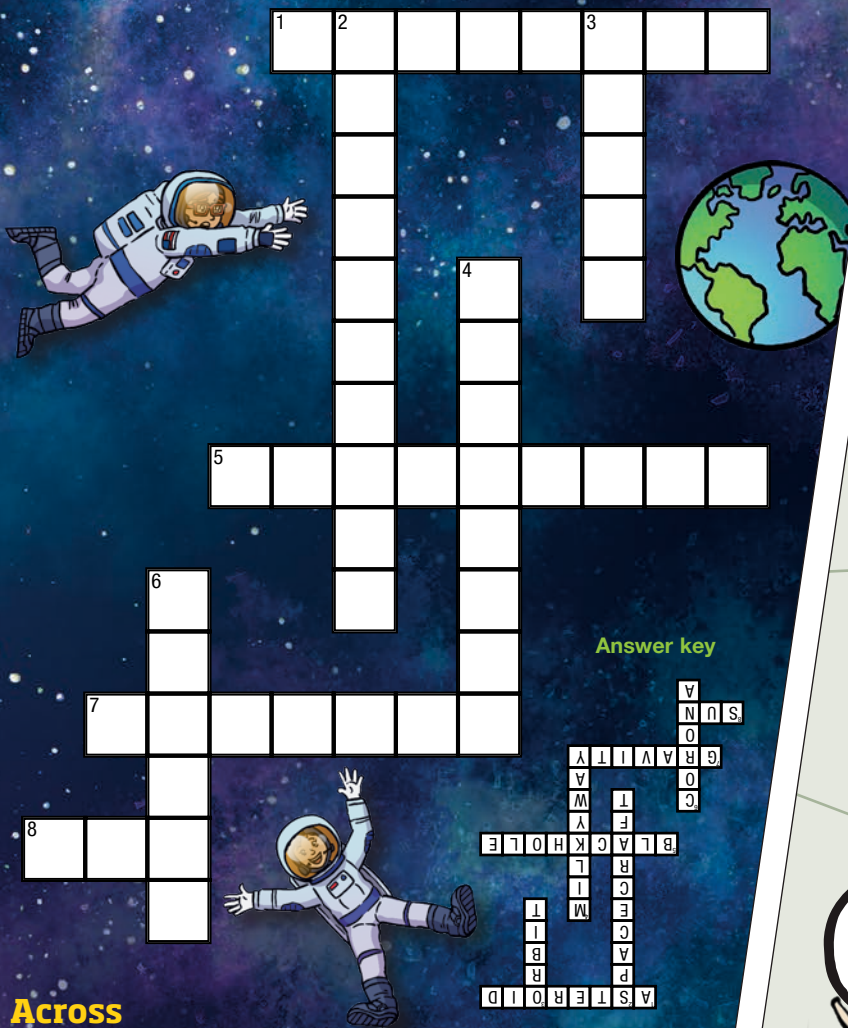

What you'll need:

Sandwich bag	Straw
Instant pudding	Funnel
Milk	Water



Instructions: In your sandwich bag, add 1 tablespoon of pudding mix and seal the bag with the straw inside. Using a funnel, pour in a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of milk and a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water. Using your hands, mix thoroughly for 2-3 minutes and enjoy your treat the astronaut way!
