When using sharp objects, get help from an adult!

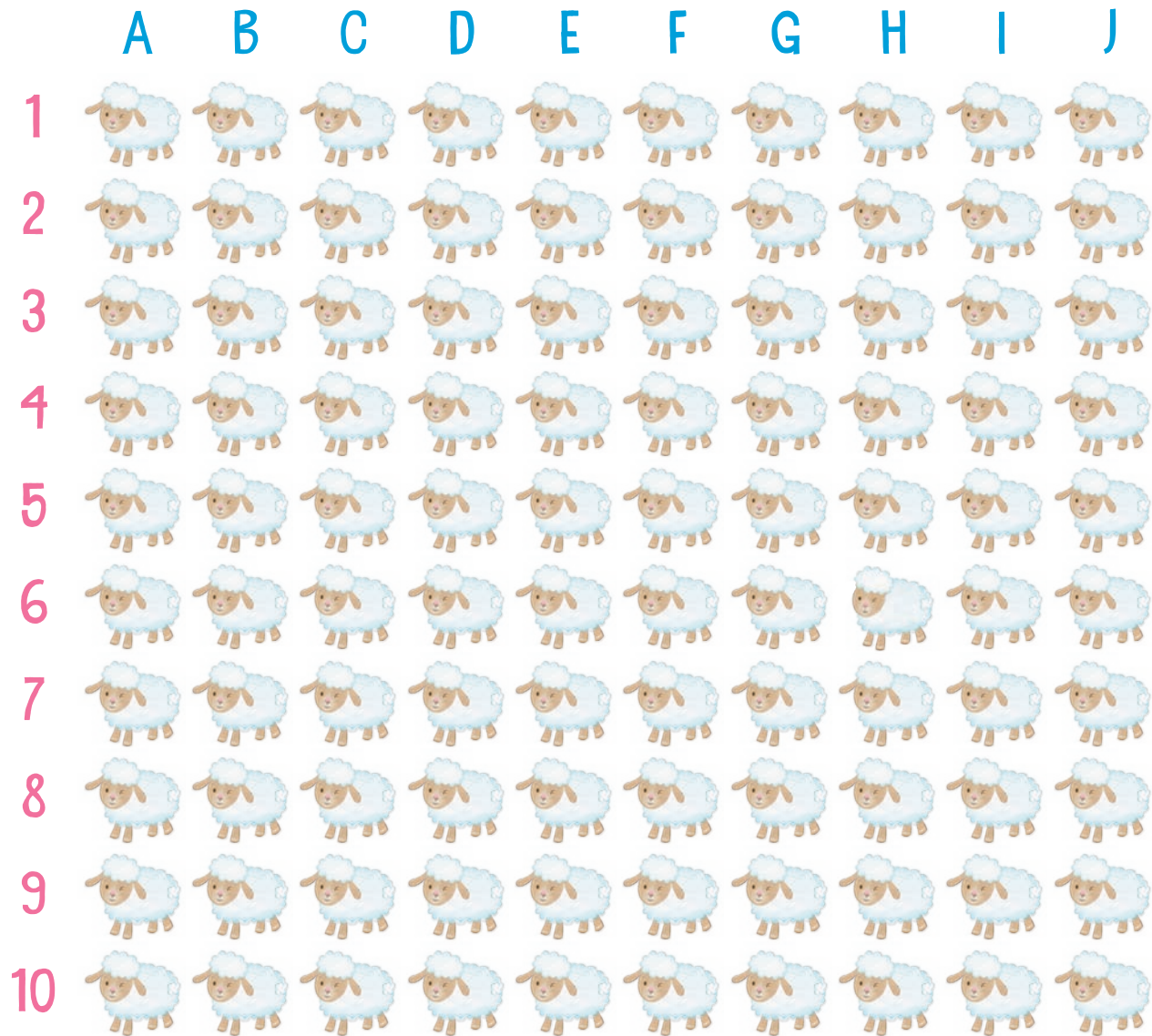

Can you count all of the sheep on this page? Use the counting chart at the end of the book to help!



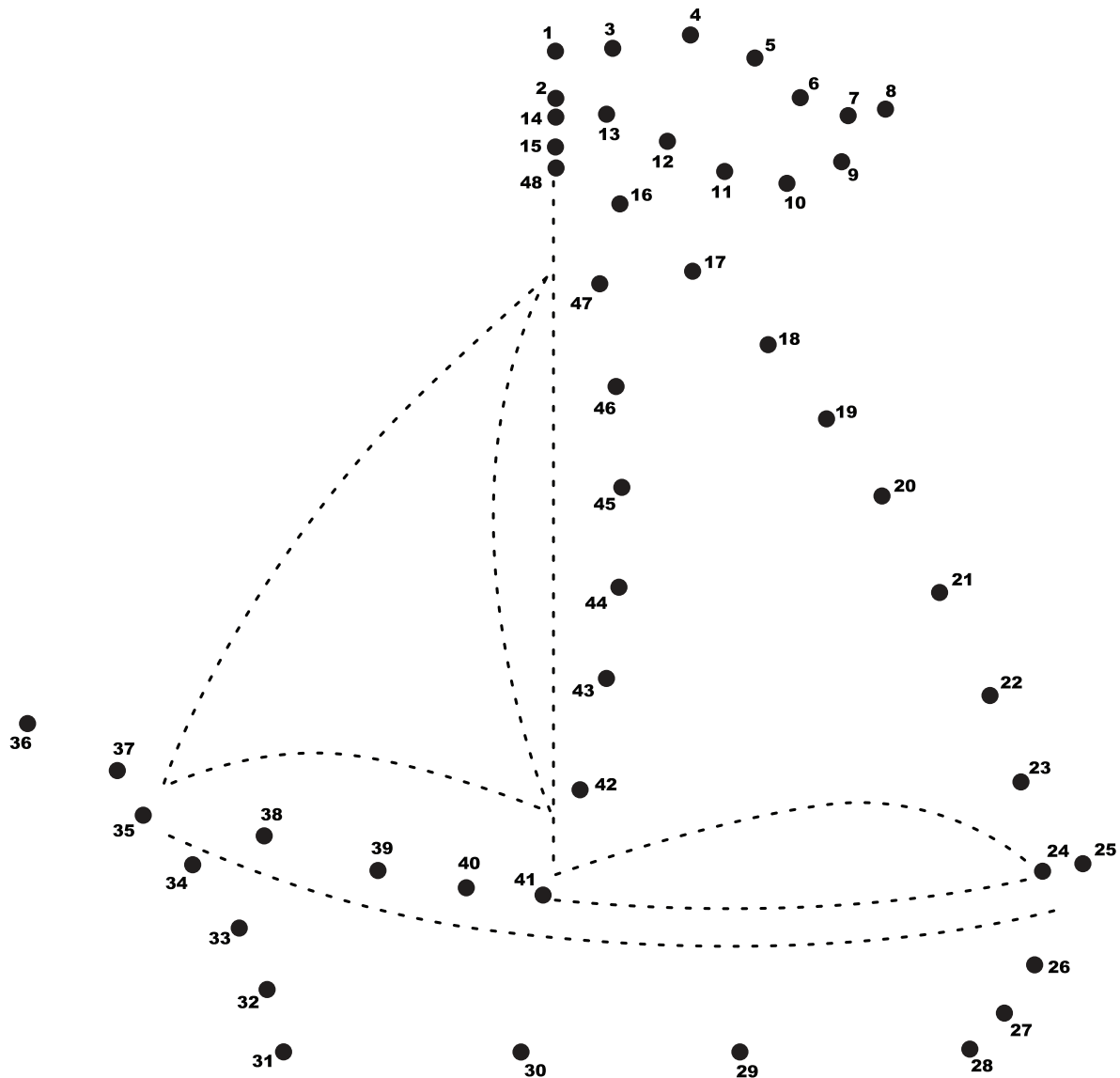

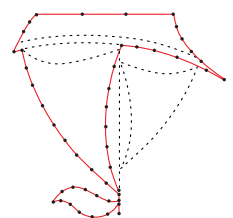

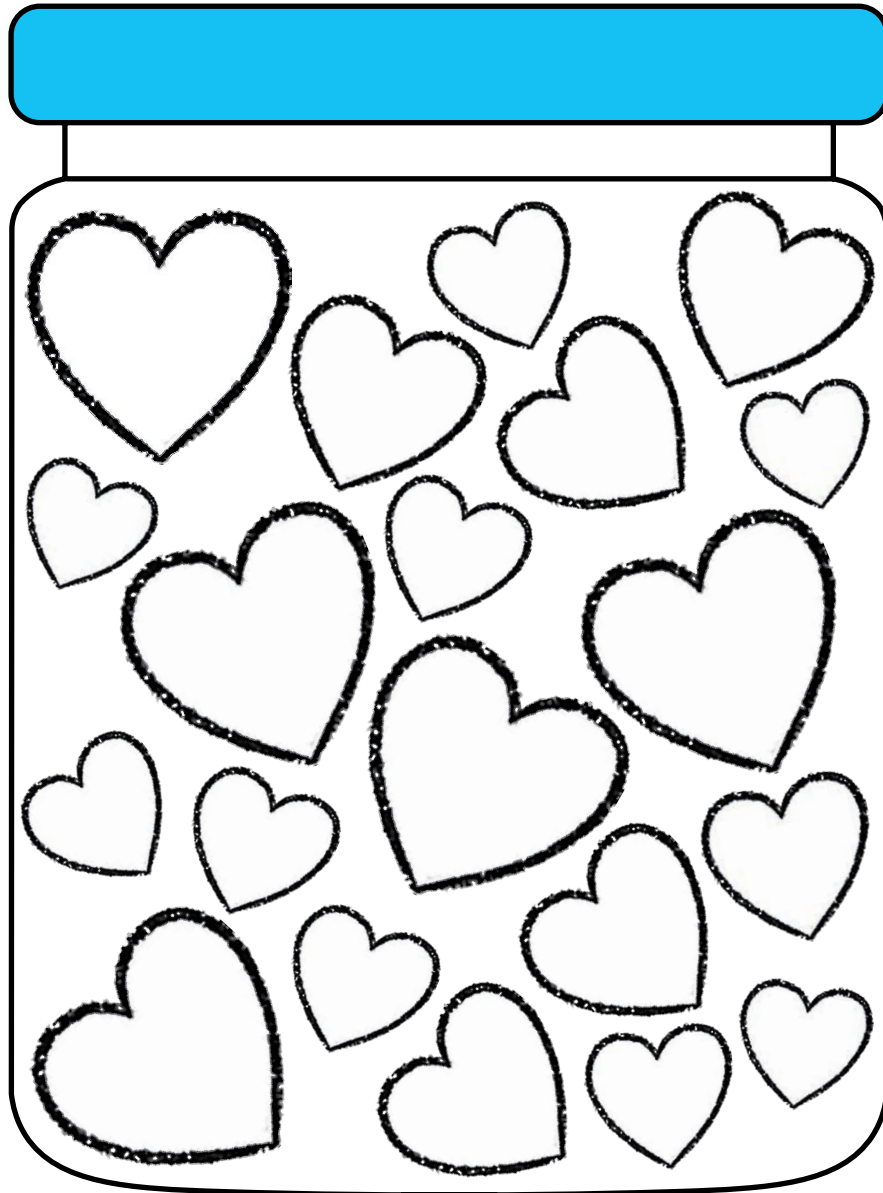
